Prior notification of a concentration

(Case COMP/M.4232 — Scottish & Newcastle/Kuehne + Nagel/JV)

- 1. On 19 May 2006 the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹) by which Scottish & Newcastle UK Ltd ('S&N', UK, part of the S&N Group) and Kuehne + Nagel Logistics Ltd ('K+N', UK, part of the K&N Group), acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of JVCo ('JV', UK) by way of purchase of shares in a newly created company constituting a joint venture.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- S&N: supply and distribution of beer and other alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks to the on-trade and off-trade in the UK;
- K+N: contract logistics in the UK;
- JV: distribution of drinks in the UK.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of Regulation (EC) No 139/2004. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
