Prior notification of a concentration (Case COMP/M.5327— Ashland/Hercules)

- 1. On 1 September 2008, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹) by which the undertaking Ashland, Inc. ('Ashland,' United States) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Hercules, Inc. ('Hercules', United States) by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for Ashland: manufacturing and supply of composite polymers, adhesives, process and utility water treatments, lubricants, automotive chemicals and distribution of chemicals plastics and composite materials,
- for Hercules: manufacturing and supply of specialty chemicals for the pulp and paper industry, water-soluble polymers (in particular, cellulose derivatives and guar) and wood rosin derivatives.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of Regulation (EC) No 139/2004. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
