Prior notification of a concentration**(Case COMP/M.6111 — Huaneng/OTPPB/Intergen)****Candidate case for simplified procedure****(Text with EEA relevance)**

1. On 10 January 2011, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 ⁽¹⁾ by which China Huaneng Group ('Huaneng', China) and Ontario Teachers Pension Plan Board ('OTPPB', Canada) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation joint control of InterGen NV ('InterGen', The Netherlands), currently controlled by GMR Infrastructure ('GMR', Malta) and OTPPB, by way of purchase of shares.

2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- for Huaneng: electricity power generation,
- for OTPPB: management of pension fund assets,
- for InterGen: development and operation of electricity generation facilities.

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved. Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under the EC Merger Regulation ⁽²⁾ it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in the Notice.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
