## EUROPEAN COMMISSION

**Prior notification of a concentration****(Case COMP/M.6204 — Linea/Donalink)****Candidate case for simplified procedure****(Text with EEA relevance)**

(2011/C 117/15)

1. On 5 April 2011, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 <sup>(1)</sup> by which Linea Ltd ('Linea', Bermuda) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation sole control over Donalink Limited ('Donalink', Cyprus) in which currently Linea, STI Limited ('STI', Jersey) and Altmirco Enterprises Limited ('Altmirco', Cyprus) are the shareholders. The only operating company that Linea controls (indirectly) is OJSC MCC Eurochem Russia Agrochemicals ('Eurochem', Russia). The only operating company that Donalink controls is Open Joint Stock Company Siberian Coal Energy Company ('SUEK', Russia).

2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

— for Linea: investment holding,

— for Eurochem: mining of minerals for fertilizers and the manufacture and sale of fertilizers,

— for Donalink: investment holding,

— for SUEK: coal mining activities in Russia, supply of coal to customers worldwide and power generation in Russia.

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved. Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under the EC Merger Regulation <sup>(2)</sup> it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in the Notice.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
