

Prior notification of a concentration
(Case COMP/M.6255 — Terex/Demag Cranes)

(Text with EEA relevance)

(2011/C 200/06)

1. On 1 July 2011, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 ⁽¹⁾ by which the undertaking Terex Corporation, ('Terex', United States) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Demag Cranes (Germany) by way of public bid announced on 19 May 2011.

2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- for Terex: global manufacturer of machinery products used in construction, infrastructure, quarrying, mining, shipping, transportation, refining, energy and utilities,
- for Demag Cranes: industrial cranes, crane components, harbour cranes and port automation technology.

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
