Prior notification of a concentration

(Case COMP/M.6563 — Mexichem SIH/Wavin)

1. On 23 April 2012, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹) by which Mexichem Soluciones Integrales Holding SA de C.V. ('Mexichem') acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation sole control of the whole of the undertaking Wavin N.V. ('Wavin'), by way of a public bid announced on 9 March 2012.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- Mexichem is specialised in the development, production and global marketing of PVC and plasticizers as well as the production and supply of some intermediates. Mexichem also produces PVC pipe systems, joints and plastic accessories for fluid conduction, primarily water, and others like electricity and natural gas,
- Wavin is specialised in the manufacture and supply of pipe systems from various materials. Wavin produces and sells pipe systems and solutions for gas, water, sewage, drainage, cable ducting and other construction purposes, together with the fittings for such systems.

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
