## Prior notification of a concentration

## (Case COMP/M.6862 — Vinci/Aeroportos de Portugal)

(Text with EEA relevance)

- 1. On 2 May 2013, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹) by which the undertaking Vinci, France, acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Aeroportos de Portugal ('ANA'), Portugal, by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for undertaking Vinci: concessions and infrastructures (mainly motorways and parking lots; and airports
  in France and in Cambodia), electrical engineering, climatic engineering and mechanical engineering;
  building works and civil engineering; road works,
- for undertaking ANA: management and operation of airport infrastructures in Portugal.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
