Prior notification of a concentration

Candidate case for simplified procedure

1. On 11 November 2016, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹), by which the undertaking DCNS SA ('DCNS', based in France, controlled jointly by the French State and the Thales group, itself controlled jointly by the French State and the Marcel Dassault group) and the fund SPI Société de Projets Industriels ('SPI', based in France, represented and managed by the undertaking Bpifrance Investissement, a member of the BPI group, itself controlled by the French State and the Caisse des Dépôts et Consignations) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation joint control of DCNS Energies', France) by way of purchase of shares.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- DCNS: undertaking specialising in the design, construction and maintenance of submarines, surface vessels, naval defence systems and weapons systems, and in engineering, construction, installation, maintenance and project management in the marine renewable energy sector,
- SPI: professional private equity fund investing in key projects for French industry,
- DCNS Energies: undertaking grouping together all DCNS's activities in the marine renewable energy sector (ocean thermal energy, floating wind power and wave energy).

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved. Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (²), it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in this Notice.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit any observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
