# REGULATION (EEC) No 1382/75 OF THE COMMISSION

of 29 May 1975

## altering the import levies on products processed from cereals and rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC (¹) of 13 June 1967 on the common organization of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 85/75 (²), and in particular Article 14 (4) thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC (3) of 25 July 1967 on the common organization of the market in rice, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 476/75 (4), and in particular Article 12 (4) thereof;

Whereas the import levies on products processed from cereals and rice were fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 1111/75 (5), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1336/75 (6);

Whereas the levy on the basic product as last fixed differs from the average levy by more than 0.25 unit

of account per 100 kilogrammes of basic product; whereas, pursuant to Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1579/74 (7), the levies at present in force must therefore be altered as shown in the table annexed to this Regulation,

### HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

### Article 1

The import levies to be charged on products processed from cereals and rice covered by Regulation (EEC) No 1052/68 (8), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 980/75 (9), as fixed in the Annex to amended Regulation (EEC) No 1111/75 are hereby altered as shown in the table annexed to this Regulation.

#### Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 30 May 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
