COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 631/77

of 25 March 1977

abolishing the countervailing charge on cucumbers originating in Greece

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 of 18 May 1972 on the common organization of the market in fruit and vegetables (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 795/76 (2), and in particular Article 27 (2) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 515/77 of 14 March 1977 (3), introduced a countervailing charge on cucumbers originating in Greece;

Whereas, for this product originating in Greece there were no prices for six consecutive working days;

Whereas the conditions specified in Article 26 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 are therefore fulfilled, and the countervailing charge on imports of these products originating in Greece can be abolished,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 515/77 is hereby repealed.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 26 March 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
