2010 amendments to Regulation No 54 of the Economic Commission for Europe of the United Nations (UN/ECE) — Uniform provisions concerning the approval of pneumatic tyres for commercial vehicles and their trailers

Amendments to the main text of the Regulation

Paragraph 1, amend to read (including the addition of footnote (**)):

‘1. SCOPE

This Regulation covers new pneumatic tyres designed primarily for vehicles of categories M₂, M₃, N, O₃ and O₄ (*) (**). However, it does not apply to tyre types identified by speed category symbols corresponding to speeds below 80 km/h.

(*) As defined in Annex 7 to the Consolidated Resolution on the Construction of Vehicles R.E.3 (document TRANS/WP.29/78/Rev.1 as last amended by Amend. 4).

(**) This Regulation defines requirements for tyres as a component. It does not limit their installation on any categories of vehicles.’
