

Acknowledgement of receipt of complaint No 2005/4313 — SG(2005)A/1204

(2005/C 233/02)

1. The European Commission has registered a complaint regarding the exceedance of the 24-hour limit value for particulate matter (PM10) of 50 µg/m³ on more than 35 days in the year 2005 in the area of the 'Höhenstraße' in Frankfurt/ Main in Germany under complaint number 2005/4313 in the register of complaints.
 2. The Commission has received more than 30 copies of this complaint. Therefore, in order to ensure a rapid response to and information of those concerned while making the most economical use of its administrative resources, it is publishing this acknowledgment of receipt in the *Official Journal of the European Union* and on the Internet at:

 3. The complaint will be examined by the Commission in the light of the applicable Community legislation. The complainants will be kept informed, by any means, including eventually by publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union* and/or on the Internet, of the results of this examination and of any follow-up action that the Commission may decide to take.
 4. The Commission will endeavour to take a decision on the substance of the case (opening of infringement proceedings or closure of the case) within 12 months from the date of registration of the complaint by the Secretariat-General.
 5. Should the Commission need to contact the German authorities, it will do so without mentioning the identity of the complainants in order to protect their rights. The complainants may, however, authorise the Commission to reveal their identity in any contacts with the German authorities.
