**Notice regarding the application of anti-dumping and anti-subsidy measures in force in the Union
following enlargement to include the Republic of Croatia and the possibility of review**

(2013/C 137/06)

When enlargement takes place on 1 July 2013, all anti-dumping and anti-subsidy measures in force will automatically apply to imports into the enlarged 28 Member State Union. Accordingly, these measures will also apply to imports into the Republic of Croatia. On enlargement, there will be a number of pending investigations initiated before 1 July 2013. Should such investigations lead to measures, these will equally apply to imports into the 28 Member State Union.

The Commission gives notice that it is prepared to review anti-dumping and anti-subsidy measures pursuant to Article 11(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009 ⁽¹⁾ and Article 19 of Regulation (EC) No 597/2009 ⁽²⁾ where any interested party so requests and submits evidence that the measures would have been significantly different if they were based on information including the Republic of Croatia. In this regard, it should be noted that enlargement per se, in the absence of such evidence, is not a sufficient basis for a review to be initiated.
