## Information from the Commission concerning the non-application of certain provisions of Regulation (EU) 2020/698 by Sweden

#### COVID-19 outbreak

(Regulation (EU) 2020/698 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 May 2020 laying down specific and temporary measures in view of the COVID-19 outbreak concerning the renewal or extension of certain certificates, licences and authorisations and the postponement of certain periodic checks and periodic training in certain areas of transport legislation (OJ L 165, 27.5.2020, p. 10))

#### Notification by: Sweden

In conformity with the relevant provisions of Regulation (EU) 2020/698, **Sweden informed the Commission on 2 June 2020** that it has decided not to apply certain provisions of the Regulation (EU) 2020/698.

#### Provisions of Regulation (EU) 2020/698 that Sweden has decided not to apply:

- Article 4(1) concerning the regular inspections of tachographs in road transport under Regulation (EU) No 165/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council (¹);
- Article 4(2) concerning the renewal of driver cards under Regulation (EU) No 165/2014;
- Article 4(3) concerning the replacement of driver cards under Regulation (EU) No 165/2014.
