### Order of the General Court (Fifth Chamber) of 7 March 2013 — UOP v Commission

(Case T-198/09)

(Action for annulment — State aid — No individual concern — Inadmissibility)

1. *Actions for annulment — Natural or legal persons — Measures of direct and individual concern to them — Commission decision terminating an aid proceeding — Competitor of the undertaking receiving the aid — Right to bring an action — Conditions (Arts 88(2) EC and 230, fourth para., EC) (see paras 22-27, 35)*
2. *Procedure — Time-limit for producing evidence — Article 48(1) of the Rules of Procedure of the General Court — Scope (Rules of Procedure of the General Court, Arts 48(1) and 66(2)) (see para. 32)*

#### Operative part

The Court:

1. The action is dismissed as inadmissible.
2. UOP Ltd is ordered to bear its own costs and pay those incurred by the European Commission and IFP.
