Re:

Application to annul the decision to reject the complaint of psychological harassment lodged by the applicant against the Chief Operating Officer of the EEAS.

Operative part of the judgment

The Tribunal:

1. Annuls the decision of 14 April 2014 by which the European External Action Service rejected the request for assistance under Articles 12a and 24 of the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union made by Mr De Loecker;
2. Orders the European External Action Service to bear its own costs and to pay the costs incurred by Mr De Loecker.

(Civil service — Officials — Promotion exercise 2014 — General implementing provisions for Article 45 of the Staff Regulations — List of officials proposed for promotion by the Directorates-General and the services — Omission of the applicant's name — Whether the list of officials proposed for promotion may be challenged before the Joint Promotion Committee — Failure to define a position by the Joint Promotion Committee — Consideration of comparative merits made by the appointing authority alone)

Parties

Applicant: Matteo Bonazzi (Brussels, Belgium) (represented by: M. Velardo, lawyer)

Defendant: European Commission (represented by: C. Beradis-Kayser and G. Berscheid, acting as Agents)

Re:

Annulment of the decision not to promote the applicant to the next grade (AD 12) in the European Commission's promotion exercise 2014 and the claim for damages for the non-material damage allegedly suffered.

Operative part of the judgment

The Tribunal:

1. Dismisses the action;
2. Declares that Mr Bonazzi shall bear his own costs and orders him to pay the costs incurred by the European Commission.
