Prior notification of a concentration (Case COMP/M.6535 — GLORY/Talaris Topco)

- 1. On 30 May 2012, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 and following a referral pursuant to Article 4(5) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (1) by which the undertaking GLORY Ltd (Japan) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Talaris Topco Ltd (United Kingdom) by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for GLORY Ltd: the development and manufacture of money handling machines, cash management systems, vending machines and coin operated lockers for customers in the financial, retail and leisure sectors.
- for Talaris Topco Ltd: the development and manufacture of cash management products and the provision of associated services.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
