Subject:	Proposal for a COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION on continuing coordinated demand-reduction measures for gas
	- Adoption

- 1. On 27 February 2024, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Recommendation on continuing coordinated demand-reduction measures for gas. The Recommendation builds upon the measures introduced by Council Regulation (EU) 2022/1369 of 5 August 2022 on coordinated demand-reduction measures for gas, as prolonged by Council Regulation (EU) 2023/706. The Recommendation addresses also reinforced reporting and monitoring mechanisms to ensure the continuity of voluntary gas demand reduction in the context of the preparation for the winter 2024/2025.
- 2. This proposal is based on Article 292 in conjunction with Article 194(2) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. The Council shall act by qualified majority.
- 3. On 4 March 2024, the Council reached a political agreement on the text of the draft Council Recommendation, as set out in document 6619/1/24 REV1.
