MEDICAL AND KINDRED PROFESSIONS ORDINANCE (CAP. 31)

Drugs (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2022

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by article 40 of the Medical and Kindred Professions Ordinance, the Minister responsible for public health, after consultation with the Council of Health, has made the following regulations:-

Citation and scope.

- S.L. 31.18.
- 1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Drugs (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2022 and these regulations shall be read and construed as one with the Drugs (Control) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".
- (2) These regulations transpose Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2022/1326 of 18 March 2022 amending the Annex to Council Framework Decision 2004/757/JHA as regards the inclusion of new psychoactive substances in the definition of "drug".

Amends the Second Schedule to the principal regulations. **2.** In the Second Schedule to the principal regulations, immediately after the item:

"EUTYLONE

1-(1,3-benzodioxol-5-yl)-2-(ethylamino)butan-1-one"

there shall be added the following new items:

"3-methylmethcathinone, 3- 2-(methylamino)-1-(3-methylphenyl)propan-MMC 1-one

3-chloromethcathinone, 3- 1-(3-chlorophenyl)-2-(methylamino)propan-CMC 1-one".
