#### Notice of the impending expiry of certain anti-dumping measures

(2003/C 230/02)

1. The Commission gives notice that, unless a review is initiated in accordance with the following procedure, the anti-dumping measures mentioned below will expire on the date mentioned in the table below, as provided in Article 11(2) of Council Regulation (EC) No 384/96 of 22 December 1995 (¹) on protection against dumped imports from countries not members of the European Community.

#### 2. Procedure

Community producers may lodge a written request for a review. This request must contain sufficient evidence that the removal of the measures would be likely to result in a continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury.

Should the Commission decide to review the measures concerned, importers, exporters, representatives of the exporting country and Community producers will then be provided with the opportunity to amplify, rebut or comment on the matters set out in the review request.

#### 3. Time limit

Community producers may submit a written request for a review on the above basis, to reach the European Commission, Directorate-General for Trade (Division B-1), J-79 5/16, B-1049 Brussels ( $^2$ ) at any time from the date of the publication of the present notice but no later than three months before the date mentioned in the table below.

#### Prior notification of a concentration

#### (Case COMP/M.3093 — INA/AIG/SNFA)

#### (Text with EEA relevance)

- 1. On 22 September 2003 the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89 (¹), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1310/97 (²), by which the undertakings INA-Holding Schaeffler KG ('INA', Germany), through its subsidiary FAG Kugelfischer Georg Schäfer AG ('FAG', Germany), and American International Group, Inc. ('AIG', USA) acquire, within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Regulation, joint control of the French undertaking SNFA, by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- INA: development, production and sale of various components for automotive and other industries,
- FAG: design, production and sale of anti-friction bearings and individual components thereof; production and sale of special sewing technology and material handling systems for clothing and upholstery industries,
- AIG: international insurance and financial services company,
- SNFA: design, production, distribution and marketing of precision antifriction bearings, in particular for aerospace and machine tool industries.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified concentration could fall within the scope of Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation.

#### Non-opposition to a notified concentration

#### (Text with EEA relevance)

On 11 September 2003 the Commission decided not to oppose the above notified concentration and to declare it compatible with the common market.
