Prior notification of a concentration

- 1. On 14 October 2003 the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89 (¹), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1310/97 (²), by which the undertaking Oracle Corporation ('Oracle'), USA, acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Regulation, control of the whole of the undertaking PeopleSoft Inc. ('PeopleSoft'), USA, by way of public bid announced on 9 June 2003.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- Oracle: design, development, manufacture and distribution of enterprise application software, database and application server software and related services,
- PeopleSoft: design, development, manufacture and distribution of enterprise application software and related services.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified concentration could fall within the scope of Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation.
