**UNIFORM APPLICATION OF THE COMBINED NOMENCLATURE (CN)****(Classification of goods)**

**Explanatory Notes adopted in accordance with the procedure defined in Article 10(1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 of 23 July 1987 on the tariff and statistical nomenclature and on the Common Customs Tariff<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 2344/2003<sup>(2)</sup>**

The 'Explanatory Notes to the combined nomenclature of the European Communities'<sup>(3)</sup> shall be amended as follows:

**Commission notice updating the list of parties under examination pursuant to Commission Regulation (EC) No 88/97 on the exemption from the extended anti-dumping duty on imports of certain bicycle parts originating in the People's Republic of China**

(2004/C 54/03)

Commission Regulation (EC) No 88/97<sup>(1)</sup> of 20 January 1997 authorises the exemption from the extended anti-dumping duty on imports of certain bicycle parts originating in the People's Republic of China. This duty resulted from the extension by Council Regulation (EC) No 71/97<sup>(2)</sup> of the anti-dumping duty imposed by Council Regulation (EEC) No 2474/93<sup>(3)</sup>, and maintained by Council Regulation (EC) No 1524/2000<sup>(4)</sup>. Annex I to Commission Regulation (EC) No 88/97 comprises a list of parties whose requests for authorisation for exemption from the extended duty imposed by Regulation (EC) No 71/97 were under examination.

Interested parties are hereby informed of the receipt of further requests for exemption, pursuant to Article 3 of Commission Regulation (EC) No 88/97, two of them originating from parties which had formerly withdrawn their request, and of requests which are still under examination at this stage. The suspension from the extended duty, following these requests, took effect as shown in Annex I to this notice, which constitutes an updated list of parties under examination.

#### **1. Introduction**

This call for proposals is based on Council Decision 2000/821/EC of 20 December 2000 on the implementation of a programme to encourage the development, distribution and promotion of European audiovisual works (MEDIA Plus — Development, Distribution and Promotion — 2001 to 2005) that was published in the *Official Journal of the European Communities* L 13 of 17 January 2001, p. 35.

The measures covered by the Decision include support for the transnational distribution of European cinema films.

#### **2. Purpose**

This notice is intended for European cinema distribution companies whose activities contribute to the attainment of the above objectives. It explains how to obtain the necessary documents in order to apply for financial support from the Community for proposals.

The Commission department responsible for administering this call for proposals is the Unit for ‘Support for audiovisual content’ in DG EAC, the Directorate-General for Education and Culture.
