Boogerd-Quaak, who asked to be allowed to speak, in her capacity as rapporteur, before the vote on the request for urgent procedure (the President replied that the floor would be given to one speaker in favour, one speaker against, and the rapporteur, and that a decision on procedure would then be taken; he added that he would seek a formal legal opinion on the question raised by Sarah Ludford).

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SITTING

IN THE CHAIR: Pat COX

President

1. Opening of sitting

The sitting opened at 10.05.

The following spoke:

- Sarah Ludford, who referred to the signing by the Council on 29 April 2004 of two legislative acts without having had the opinion of Parliament, the pretext being that it had fixed a deadline that Parliament had not respected; she pointed out that a similar deadline had also been set for the proposal for a Council decision on the conclusion of an Agreement between the European Community and the United States of America on the processing and transfer of PNR data by Air Carriers to the United States Department of Homeland Security, Bureau of Customs and Border Protection [COM(2004) 190 — C5-0162/2004 — 2004/0064(CNS)], in respect of which Parliament had rejected a request for urgent procedure (*Minutes of 04.05.2004, Item 7*). She called on the President to send formal requests to the Council and Commission that they should abstain from taking any decisions before the Court of Justice had given its opinion;
- Johanna L.A. Boogerd-Quaak (rapporteur on the matter), who supported the previous speaker's remarks and added that she had written to the Chairman of the JURI Committee, Giuseppe Gargani, to remind him of the procedure decided on 6 April 2004; she said that she would forward this letter to the President so that, should the Council go ahead and sign the act, a different procedure could be initiated.

(The President undertook to convey Parliament's concern to the other institutions);

- Roy Perry, on a letter sent by the Chairman of the JURI Committee to the President concerning a recommendation that action should be taken against the Commission for failure to act in a matter concerning Lloyd's (the President replied that he would contact Giuseppe Gargani and provide Roy Perry with a copy of any correspondence);
- Robert Goebbels, who referred to the announcement made the previous day by the President concerning the lapsing under Rule 185 of written declarations and pending written and oral questions (*Minutes of 04.05.2004, Item 6*); he disputed this decision on the basis of the third paragraph of that Rule ('these provisions shall not apply to petitions and communications that do not require a decision').

(The President replied that the announcement had been made on the basis of end-of-term precedents; however, in the light of Robert Goebbels' justifiable point, he would be calling on the Council and Commission to provide answers to the relevant questions; this would constitute a new precedent for the future in this regard).
