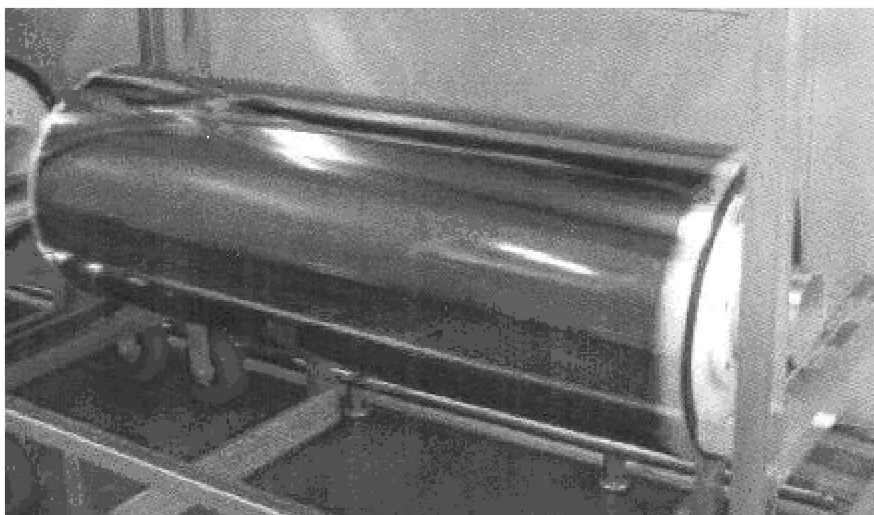
Explanatory Notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Communities*(2008/C 90/01)*

Pursuant to Article 9(1)(a), second indent, of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 of 23 July 1987 on the tariff and statistical nomenclature and on the Common Customs Tariff ⁽¹⁾, the Explanatory Notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Communities ⁽²⁾ are amended as follows:

On page 363, the following text is inserted:

'9001 20 00 Sheets and plates of polarising material

This subheading includes foils of polarising material in rolls, for example, for use in the manufacture of LCD modules.
