On 18 August 2011, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹) by which the undertakings The Dow Chemical Company ('Dow', USA) and Ube Advanced Materials Inc., belonging to the group Ube Industries, Ltd (together referred to as 'Ube', Japan) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation joint control of a newly created company constituting a joint venture ('the JV', USA).
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for Dow: supply of plastics, chemicals, agricultural products, as well as hydrocarbon and energy products and services,
- for Ube: supply of specialty chemicals, other chemicals, plastics, cement, construction materials, machinery, metal products, as well as coal storage solutions,
- for the JV: production and sale of electrolytes for lithium-ion batteries.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved. Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under the EC Merger Regulation (²) it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in the Notice.
