The following information is brought to the attention of the persons who are designated in the Annex to Council Decision 2011/172/CFSP and in Annex I to Council Regulation (EU) No 270/2011 concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Egypt.

The Council of the European Union, after having reviewed the list of persons designated in the above-mentioned Annexes, has determined that the restrictive measures provided for in Council Decision 2011/172/CFSP and in Council Regulation (EU) No 270/2011 should continue to apply to those persons.
