On 21 December 2018, the Commission decided not to oppose the above notified concentration and to declare it compatible with the internal market. This decision is based on Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 ⁽¹⁾. - FountainVest China Capital Partners GP3 ('FountainVest', Cayman Islands),
- Amer Sports ('Amer Sports', Finland).

- the Caisse des Dépôts et Consignations ('CDC', France),
- Swiss Life REIM, belonging to the Swiss Life Group ('Swiss Life', Switzerland),
- the Target Asset ('JV', France).

CDC and Swiss Life acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation joint control of the whole of JV.

The concentration is accomplished by way of purchase of assets.

- for JV: immovable property to be developed for use as a healthcare establishment, located in Bracon (department of Jura), covered by an off-plan lease.
