

Reference for a preliminary ruling from High Court (Ireland) made on 7 December 2023 — PJ Carroll & Company Ltd and Nicoventures Trading Ltd v The Minister for Health, Ireland and The Attorney General

Questions referred

1. Is the delegated directive (¹) invalid on the basis that it goes beyond the powers granted by Articles 7(12) and 11(6) of Directive 2014/40/EU (²), in light of Article 290 TFEU, and taking into account Article 2(14), 19 and 28 of Directive 2014/40/EU?

2. Is the delegated directive invalid on the basis that the Commission was not entitled to conclude that there was a substantial change of circumstances within the meaning of Article 7(12) and/or 11(6) and/or 2(28) of Directive 2014/40/EU?
