**Judgment of the General Court of 26 June 2024 – Fest v Parliament**

**(Case T-305/23) <sup>(1)</sup>**

***(Law governing the institutions – Member of Parliament – Privileges and immunities – Decision to waive parliamentary immunity – Articles 8 and 9 of Protocol No 7 on the privileges and immunities of the EU – Concept of ‘connection to parliamentary duties’ – Manifest error of assessment)***

**Parties**

*Applicant:* Nicolaus Fest (Zagreb, Croatia) (represented by: G. Seidel, lawyer)

*Defendant:* European Parliament (represented by: N. Lorenz and A.-M. Dumbrăvan, acting as Agents)

**Re:**

By its action based on Article 263 TFEU, the applicant seeks annulment of European Parliament Decision P9\_TA(2023) 0061, of 14 March 2023, on the request to waive his immunity.

**Operative part of the judgment**

The Court:

1. Dismisses the action;
2. Orders Mr Nicolaus Fest to bear his own costs and pay those incurred by the European Parliament.
