- 3. Lucchini Siderurgica S.p.A. has been fined the sum of ECU 411 600 being Lit 544 699 092 for having infringed Decision No 2794/80/ECSC implementing Article 58 of the ECSC Treaty by having exceeded the production quota category IV for the first quarter of 1981 by 5 488 tonnes.

Acciaierie e Ferriere Stefana Fratelli fu Girolamo S.p.A. has been fined the sum of ECU 48 450 being Lit 64 117 276 for having infringed Decision No 2794/80/ECSC implementing Article 58 of the ECSC Treaty by having exceeded the production quota category III for the first quarter of 1981 by 94 tonnes as well as the production quota category IV for the second quarter of 1981 by 552 tonnes.

 Exceptional opening, for 1982, of quotas for the import of aluminium alloy waste recast into ingots containing less than 97.5 % aluminium (Common Customs Tariff subheading 76.01 ex A)
