

**Commission communication pursuant to Article 9 (9) of Council Regulation (EEC)
No 3420/83 of 14 November 1983**

By virtue of Article 9 (1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 3420/83 of 14 November 1983 on import arrangements for products originating in State-trading countries, not liberalized at Community level ⁽¹⁾, the Commission has adopted the following change to the import arrangements applied in Italy with regard to Poland with effect from 19 June 1984:

- exceptional opening, for 1984, of a quota of Lit 750 000 000 for the import of footwear for sports, of leather (Common Customs Tariff subheading 64.02 ex A).
