Notice relating to the anti-dumping proceeding concerning imports of videocassette tapes originating in the Republic of Korea and Hong Kong

(88/C 212/03)

On 18 December 1987, the Commission of the European Communities published a notice (1) concerning imports of videocassette tapes originating in the Republic of Korea and Hong Kong.

The complainant has now alleged that there is a history of dumping which caused injury and that the importers were, or should have been, aware that the exporters practised dumping and that such dumping would cause injury. It also alleged that injury is caused by massive imports in a relatively short period. Consequently the Commission will examine whether, pursuant to Article 13 (4) (b) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2176/84 (2), the imposition of anti-dumping duties with retroactive effect is warranted.
