market prices without leading to the formation of
structural surplus within the Community;

Whereas the guide prices for the said products were
fixed for the 1976 fishing year by Regulation (EEC)
No 115/76 ⁽³⁾;

Whereas the application of the criteria aforesaid
defined in Article 9 of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76

involves, for the 1977 fishing year, for some products,
an increase in prices by comparison with those valid
for the current fishing year; whereas in the absence of
complete information concerning price trends for
each fishery product with given commercial specifica-
tions, consideration should be given to the relation-
ship between the average weighted market prices
recorded when the guide prices were fixed for the
previous fishing year for these products, and the
average weighted market prices now current,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The guide prices applicable until 31 December 1977
for products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to Regula-
tion (EEC) No 100/76 and the products to which they
relate are hereby fixed in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January
1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission, Whereas Article 9 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 provides that intervention prices should be fixed for fresh or chilled sardines and anchovies at a level designed to ensure the stability of market prices without leading to the formation of structural surpluses in the Community;

Whereas Article 9 (3) of the same Regulation provides that the intervention price should be fixed at a level between 35 and 45 % of the guide price depending

on the production and marketing characteristics peculiar to each product;

Whereas the guide prices for fishery products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 have been fixed for the 1977 fishing year by Regulation (EEC) No 3120/76 ⁽³⁾;

Whereas given the present state of information on the market situation for the products in question and the absence of any experience in relation to purchase on the open market of these products, the intervention prices should be fixed at a level such as to ensure maximum support of the market,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 of 19 January 1976 on the common organization of the market in fishery products⁽¹⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2429/76⁽²⁾, and in particular the first subparagraph of Article 19 (6) thereof,

Whereas Article 19 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 provides *inter alia* for the fixing each year of reference prices valid in the Community for the products listed in Annexes I (A) and (C), II and IV (B) to that Regulation;

Whereas Article 19 (2) of the Regulation aforesaid provides that for the products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) thereto such price is to be equal to not less than 60 % and not more than 90 % of the guide price;

Whereas the guide prices for the fishery products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 have been fixed for the 1977 fishing year by Council Regulation (EEC) No 3120/76 of 16 December 1976⁽³⁾;

Whereas it is essential to fix reference prices if appropriate measures are to be applied to protect Community production; whereas the implementation of such measures is closely linked with those taken within the Community to stabilize markets, in particular by the application of the system of withdrawal prices, that is prices below which producers' organizations will not put up for sale the produce of their members; whereas the reference price must be fixed by applying to the guide price a percentage lying within the limits used in applying the withdrawal price; whereas this percentage must be based in particular on the supply and demand situation on the market;

Whereas for these reasons the withdrawal prices, to the extent that these lie within the limits set for this

purpose, and otherwise the lower of those limits, should be used in determining reference prices;

Whereas the reference prices for the products listed in Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 must be derived from the guide prices therefor and fixed by reference to the price level at which intervention measures in respect of these products become applicable; whereas the reference prices for these products should therefore be fixed at 85 % of the guide prices fixed for the 1977 fishing year by Council Regulation (EEC) No 3121/76 of 16 December 1976⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas, for the products listed in Annex IV (B) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76, reference prices are determined on the basis of the reference price for the fresh product;

Whereas the situation on the Community import market for frozen products as specified in Annex IV (B) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 may make it necessary to take measures to protect Community producers, particularly as frozen products may be used in place of fresh products; whereas the reference price for these products should therefore be higher than those for fresh products;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Fishery Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The reference prices applicable until 31 December 1977 for the products listed in Annexes I (A) and (C) and II and for frozen products as specified in Annex IV (B) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 shall be as shown in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1977.

Whereas application of the withdrawal arrangements is to contribute towards stabilizing the market without, however, provoking structural surpluses in the Community; whereas, therefore, appropriate support to all markets must be promoted, bearing in mind the differences between the commercial specifications of the various products landed as between various markets; whereas the withdrawal prices must furthermore be so fixed that the results of the endeavours of the producers' organizations in the Member States to stabilize prices will not be jeopardized, to the extent that they contribute to the attainment of Community objectives;

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 3559/73 fixed the conversion factors reflecting the average price difference between a product with specific commercial specifications and products of the quality immediately below that of the product taken into consideration; whereas price trends on the Community markets require an amendment to the conversion factor for shrimps of size '1';

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 108/76 of 19 January 1976⁽⁵⁾ laid down general rules for deter-

mining, in the fishery sector, the landing areas situated at a considerable distance from the main centres of consumption in the Community;

Whereas it is provided in the second subparagraph of Article 11 (4) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 that, in order to ensure that producers in landing areas which are very distant from the main centres of consumption in the Community have access to markets under satisfactory conditions, the withdrawal prices may be multiplied by conversion factors for those areas; whereas these factors are to be determined in such a way that the differences between the prices thus converted correspond to the price disparities to be expected in the case of normal production on the basis of the natural conditions of price formation on the market; whereas it is necessary to re-determine the area for hake;

Whereas examination of the trend of the market price for mackerel and hake in those areas and therefore the price formation to be expected call for the re-fixing of the corresponding conversion factors;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Fishery Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Annexes I and III to Regulation (EEC) No 3559/73 are hereby replaced by Annexes I and II to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

Whereas the compensatory amounts applicable in the beef and veal sector should be fixed in accordance with the rules laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 181/73; whereas the guide prices have been fixed by Council Regulation (EEC) No 558/76 of 15 March 1976 (3); whereas the calculations shown in Article 1 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 181/73 have been carried out by means of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2249/73 of 17 August 1973 fixing the coefficients for calculating the levy on beef and veal other than frozen (4); whereas the coefficients referred to in Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 181/73 were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2260/73 of 17 August 1973 determining the bases for calculating the levy on certain kinds of frozen beef and veal (5), as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1160/74 (6);

Whereas under Commission Regulation (EEC) No 523/75 of 28 February 1975 laying down special rules for the application of accession compensatory amounts with a view to preventing deflection of trade in beef and veal (7), the compensatory amounts for products falling within subheadings 02.01 A II a) 1 cc), 02.01 A II a) 2 dd) 11 and dd) 22 ccc) and 02.06 C I a) of the Common Customs Tariff are to be fixed at

levels below those resulting from application of the rules for calculating the levy;

Whereas the import price referred to in Article 5 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 181/73 is calculated in accordance with Commission Regulation (EEC) No 218/73 of 29 January 1973 on the calculation of import prices and the fixing of special import terms for calves and adult bovine animals (8), as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 532/76 (9);

Whereas the world market price referred to in Article 5 (4) (b) of Regulation (EEC) No 181/73 is determined in accordance with Council Regulation (EEC) No 990/68 of 15 July 1968 on general rules for fixing the levy on certain kinds of frozen beef and veal (10), and Regulation (EEC) No 2260/73;

Whereas the compensatory amounts for calves and veal are identical with those applicable to adult bovine animals and beef in accordance with Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1100/74 of 3 May 1974 (11),

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The compensatory amounts applicable in the beef and veal sector are fixed in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 3 January 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 1687/76 is amended as follows:

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in oils and fats⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1707/73⁽²⁾, and in particular Articles 11 (5) and 26 (3) thereof, and the corresponding provisions of the other Regulations establishing a common organization of the market in respect of agricultural products,

1. Article 3 (d) is amended to read as follows:

'(d) in respect of products to be sold for direct consumption as concentrated products, they have been concentrated, wrapped in paper and taken over by the retail trade.'

Whereas Article 3 (d) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1687/76 of 30 June 1976 laying down common detailed rules for verifying the use and/or destination of products from intervention⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3110/76⁽⁴⁾, provides that in respect of products to be sold for direct consumption as concentrated products such products shall be considered as having complied with the prescribed use and/or destination when it is established that they have been concentrated and wrapped in paper; whereas this provision is not considered adequate to ensure that such products will reach the prescribed use and/or destination; whereas it is necessary to strengthen the control;

2. The Annex is amended as follows:

1. under 'I. Products to be exported in the same state as that in which they were when removed from intervention stock', paragraphs 5 and 8 and the corresponding footnotes are deleted;
2. under 'II. Products subject to a use and/or destination other than that mentioned under I', paragraphs 4, 9, 10 and 11 and the corresponding footnotes are deleted.

A further paragraph as follows is added after paragraph 5:

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 2575/76 amending or repealing various Regulations concerning intervention in the milk sector⁽⁵⁾ repealed Regulations (EEC) No 1519/72, (EEC) No 71/73, (EEC) No 2978/74, (EEC) No 3178/75, (EEC) No 3253/75 and (EEC) No 3354/75; whereas references to these Regulations should be deleted in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1687/76;

'5a. Commission Regulation (EEC) No 349/73 of 31 January 1973 on the sale at reduced prices of intervention butter for direct consumption as concentrated butter⁽¹⁾:

— Section 104: "for direct consumption (Regulation (EEC) No 349/73)";

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3376/75 of 23 December 1975⁽³⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1501/76⁽⁴⁾, laid down the rules for the application of Regulation (EEC) No 3328/75; whereas following the extension of the import arrangements for beef and veal originating in certain African, Caribbean and Pacific States, certain provisions of Regulation (EEC) No 3376/75 require amendment;

Whereas, in order to avoid abuses, provision should be made for charging the full amount of the levies fixed in accordance with Articles 10 to 13 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal⁽⁵⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 568/76⁽⁶⁾, in respect of the quantities imported pursuant to Article 2 (4) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 193/75 of 17 January 1975 laying down common detailed rules for the application of the system of import and export licences and advance fixing certificates for agricultural products⁽⁷⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2219/76⁽⁸⁾;

Whereas because of the geographical situation and the climate of the States concerned, particularly Botswana, beef and veal production is concentrated at the beginning of the year; whereas accordingly the dates for the submission of applications for import licences and for the issue of licences for January 1977 should be brought forward;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 2 (4) of Regulation (EEC) No 3376/75 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'4. The import licences shall be valid only until 31 December of the year of issue.'

Article 2

Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 3376/75 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Article 4

1. The amount provided for in Article 1 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3328/75 for each product intended for importation into Ireland or the United Kingdom shall be equal to 90 % of the amount resulting from the levy reduced by the accession compensatory amount applicable to imports into the United Kingdom from non-member countries and by the monetary compensatory amount which are valid for imports into that Member State during the week preceding that in which commences the quarter for which the amount of the reduction is calculated.

2. The amount provided for in Article 1 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3328/75 for each product intended for importation into a Member State other than those mentioned in paragraph 1 shall be equal to 90 % of the amount resulting from the levy adjusted, where appropriate, by the monetary compensatory amount applicable for France during the week preceding that in which commences the quarter for which the amount of the reduction is calculated.'
