THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular the first paragraph of Article 115 thereof,

Having regard to the application under the first paragraph of Article 115 of the Treaty, made on 7 October 1976 by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany to the Commission by telex from the Office of its Permanent Representative to the European Communities for authorization not to apply Community treatment to women's, girls' and infants' shirts and blouses, falling within subheading 61.02 ex B of the Common Customs Tariff, originating in Taiwan and in free circulation in the Netherlands,

Whereas imports into the Community of the products in question originating in Taiwan are subject to a Community quantitative quota established by Council Regulation (EEC) No 1783/75 of 10 July 1975 on rules for imports of certain textile products originating in Taiwan ⁽¹⁾;

Whereas this quota is administered by allocation among the Member States, as determined by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1849/75 of 18 July 1975 allocating quantitative quotas in respect of imports into the Community of certain textile products origi-

nating in Taiwan ⁽²⁾; whereas the quota shares allocated for 1976 to the Benelux countries and the Federal Republic of Germany are 696 000 and 576 000 items respectively;

Whereas, since it was not possible when the Community quota was opened to achieve full alignment of the import arrangements previously applied in the Member States, the above Regulation (EEC) No 1783/75 provides, as a temporary measure, for a derogation from the principle of equal and continuous access for all Community importers to Community quotas by stipulating that the quota in question be allocated initially on the basis of the volume of imports previously admitted into the various Member States and that it need be adjusted only progressively to the supply requirements of the markets;

Whereas for this reason this allocation of the quota in question still involves certain disparities in the quota shares fixed for the various Member States by reference to the supply requirements of the markets concerned;

Whereas these disparities have caused in the Federal Republic of Germany a flow of imports of the products in question, originating in Taiwan and in free circulation in the Netherlands, which threatens to continue and to grow;

Whereas there are serious economic difficulties in the branch of the textile industry concerned, resulting in a progressive decline of production and a constant reduction of the number of workers employed in that sector ;

Whereas it is not possible at the present time to set in motion the machinery for bringing about the necessary cooperation from the Netherlands ;

Whereas authorization should be given, for a limited period, for the application of protective measures under the first paragraph of Article 115 subject to the conditions laid down by the Commission Decision of 12 May 1971 ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 1 thereof,

Having regard to the application under the first paragraph of Article 115 of the Treaty, made on 19 November 1976 by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany to the Commission by telex from the Office of its Permanent Representative to the European Communities, for authorization not to apply Community treatment to woven fabrics of regenerated textile fibres, containing 85 % or more by weight of regenerated textile fibres, unbleached or bleached, falling within subheading ex 56.07 B of the Common Customs Tariff, originating in the People's Republic of China and in free circulation in Denmark,

Whereas for the fabrics falling within subheading ex 56.07 of the Common Customs Tariff, the Federal Republic of Germany, in accordance with the Council Decision of 18 December 1975⁽¹⁾, opened in respect of the People's Republic of China a quota of DM 1 200 000 for 1976, which has been used up;

Whereas indirect imports, which would be in addition to those already effected, would be likely to aggravate these economic difficulties;

Whereas it is not possible at the present time to set in motion rapidly the machinery for bringing about the necessary cooperation from Denmark and the other Member States;

Whereas authorization should accordingly be given for the application of protective measures, under the first paragraph of Article 115 of the Treaty, subject to the conditions specified in the Commission Decision of 12 May 1971⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 1 thereof,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Federal Republic of Germany is hereby authorized not to apply Community treatment to woven fabrics of regenerated textile fibres, containing 85 % or more by weight of regenerated textile fibres, unbleached or bleached, falling within subheading ex 56.07 B of the Common Customs Tariff, where they originate in the People's Republic of China and are in free circulation in Denmark, and in respect of which applications for import licences were lodged after 9 November 1976.

This Decision shall apply until new opportunities arise in the Federal Republic of Germany for the importation of the products in question from the People's Republic of China and in any case not later than 31 December 1976.

Whereas the Italian Republic has made an application for reimbursement in connection with all its expenditure incurred in respect of premiums granted during 1975;

Whereas this application is in accordance with the provisions of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1096/71 of 27 May 1971 concerning applications for the reimbursement of premiums granted by Member States for grubbing apple trees, pear trees and peach trees⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas an examination of the information provided shows that eligible premiums amounting to Lit 239 778 380 (383 645 40 u.a.) were paid under the conditions laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 2517/69 and its rules of application;

Whereas the Guidance Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund should therefore reimburse 50 % thereof, i.e. Lit 119 889 190 (191 822 70 u.a.);

Whereas the Fund Committee has been consulted on the financial aspects and in particular as to the funds available,

April 1975 on mountain and hill farming and farming
in certain less-favoured areas⁽¹⁾, and in particular
Article 2 (3) thereof,

Whereas Council Directive 75/272/EEC of 28 April
1975 concerning the Community list of less-favoured
areas within the meaning of Directive 75/268/EEC
(Ireland)⁽²⁾ indicates the areas of Ireland which are
included in the Community list of less-favoured areas
within the meaning of Article 3 (4) of Directive
75/268/EEC;

Whereas the Government of Ireland has applied
under Article 2 (1) of Directive 75/268/EEC, to have
the boundaries of the areas listed in the Annex to
Directive 75/272/EEC adjusted as shown in the
Annex hereto;

Whereas the areas resulting from the proposed adjust-
ments, as they appear in the documents communi-
cated and the declarations made by the Irish Govern-
ment, meet the criteria which were applied in Direc-
tive 75/272/EEC when fixing the less-favoured areas
within the meaning of Article 3 (4) of Directive
75/268/EEC;

Whereas the adjustments requested by the Irish
Government do not have the effect of increasing the

effective amount of agricultural land of all the areas by
more than 0.5 % of the total effected agricultural area
of Ireland;

Whereas the EAGGF Committee has been consulted
on the financial aspects;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision
are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing
Committee on Agricultural Structures,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The list of less-favoured areas in Ireland contained in
the Annex to Directive 75/272/EEC is hereby
amended as shown in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to Ireland.

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 729/70 of 21 April 1970 on the financing of the common agricultural policy⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2788/72⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (1) thereof,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1353/73 of 15 May 1973 introducing a premium system for the conversion of dairy cow herds to meat production and a development premium for the specialized raising of cattle for meat production⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 266/75⁽⁴⁾, and in particular Articles 16 (2) and 17 (2) thereof;

Whereas the Kingdom of Denmark has made an application for reimbursement in respect of expenditure incurred in respect of premiums granted during 1975;

Whereas this application is in accordance with the provisions of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2641/74 of 15 October 1974 concerning applications for the refund by the Guidance Section of the EAGGF of premiums for the conversion of dairy herds to meat production and of development premiums for the specialized raising of cattle for meat production⁽⁵⁾;

Whereas an examination of the information provided shows that eligible premiums amounting to Dkr 9 948 207.69 (1 326 427.69 u.a.) were paid under the conditions laid down in Articles 1 to 4 of Regulation

(EEC) No 1353/73 and its detailed rules of application; whereas the Guidance Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund should therefore reimburse 50 % thereof, i.e. Dkr 4 974 103.85 (663 213.85 u.a.);

Whereas the Fund Committee has been consulted on the financial aspects and in particular as to the funds available,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The contribution by the Guidance Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund towards the expenditure incurred by the Kingdom of Denmark during 1975 in respect of premiums for the conversion of dairy herds to meat production and of development premiums for the specialized raising of cattle for meat production shall be Dkr 4 974 103.85 (663 213.85 u.a.).

Whereas pursuant to Article 11 of Commission Regu-
lation (EEC) No 216/69 of 4 February 1969 on
detailed rules of application for the disposal of frozen
beef and veal bought in by intervention agencies ⁽³⁾,
the minimum selling prices for the products put up
for sale by tender should be fixed taking into account
tenders submitted;

Whereas, in accordance with Article 1 of Commission
Regulation (EEC) No 79/75 of 14 January 1975 on
the sale by periodic tendering procedure of boned
beef held by the intervention agencies ⁽⁴⁾, as last
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 454/76 ⁽⁵⁾, tenders
have been invited for certain quantities of boned beef
and veal; whereas consequently the minimum selling
prices should be fixed;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision
are in accordance with the opinion of the Manage-
ment Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

1. The minimum selling prices for boned beef
stored by the intervention agencies which are to be
adopted for the invitation to tender held in accor-
dance with Regulation (EEC) No 79/75, for which the
time limit for submitting bids was 6 December 1976
shall be as set out in the Annex to this Decision.

2. Tenders submitted in response to the invitation
referred to in paragraph 1 shall be rejected unless they
are for the products listed in the Annex.
