- forestry and wood processing sector,
- development of businesses, improvement of the economic structure in the rural context,
- tourism, spas, environment and heritage,

— common measures relating to the Massif Central,

— development of human resources;

(b) an outline of the forms of assistance to be provided primarily in the form of operational programmes;

(c) an indicative financing plan at 1989 constant prices, specifying for the whole period the total appropriations to provide budgetary assistance from the Community for both the implementation of new measures covered by the priorities in (a) and multiannual measures under way or decided, before the adoption of this Community support framework, broken down as follows:
