COUNCIL DECISION

of 23 March 2012

authorising the opening of negotiations for an international agreement on the creation of the EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation

(2012/493/EU)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 218(3) and (4),

Having regard to the recommendation from the European Commission,

Whereas:

negotiations should be opened with a view to concluding an international agreement on the creation of the EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation between the European Union and its Member States and the Latin American and Caribbean countries,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

1. The Commission is hereby authorised to open negotiations for an international agreement on the creation of the EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation between the European Union and its Member States and the Latin American and Caribbean countries.

2. The negotiations shall be conducted on the basis of the negotiating directives set out in the Addendum to this Decision.

Article 2

The Commission is nominated as the Union's negotiator.

Article 3

The negotiations shall be conducted in consultation with the Latin America Working Group (COLAT/AMLAT).

Article 4

This Decision is addressed to the Commission.

DECISION OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE MEMBER STATES, MEETING WITHIN THE COUNCIL

of 23 March 2012

authorising the opening of negotiations for an international agreement on the creation of the EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation

(2012/494/EU)

THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE MEMBER STATES, MEETING WITHIN THE COUNCIL,

Having regard to the recommendation from the European Commission,

Whereas:

- (1) Negotiations should be opened with a view to concluding an international agreement on the creation of an EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation between the European Union and its Member States and the Latin American and Caribbean countries (hereinafter 'the Agreement').
- (2) By means of a Council Decision, the Commission should be authorised to negotiate the provisions of the Agreement that fall within the competence of the European Union.
- (3) The Commission should also be authorised to negotiate, on behalf of the Member States, the provisions of the Agreement that fall within the competence of the Member States,

HAVE ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Commission is hereby authorised to open negotiations for an international agreement on the creation of the EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation between the European Union and its Member States and the Latin American and Caribbean countries (hereinafter 'the Agreement').

Article 2

1. The Commission is hereby authorised to negotiate, on behalf of the Member States of the European Union, the

provisions of the Agreement that fall within the competence of the Member States.

2. A representative of the Member State holding the rotating Presidency of the Council may attend the negotiations alongside the Commission.

Article 3

The negotiations shall be conducted on the basis of the negotiating directives set out in the addendum to Council Decision 2012/493/EU of 23 March 2012 authorising the opening of negotiations for an international agreement on the creation of the EU-LAC Foundation as an international organisation (¹).

Article 4

The negotiations shall be conducted in consultation with the Latin America Working Group (COLAT/AMLAT), which shall be consulted fully and in advance of each set of negotiations on proposed negotiating lines and shall be reported to on the progress of negotiations after each meeting.

Article 5

This Decision is addressed to the Commission.

COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) No 799/2012

of 5 September 2012

laying down form and content of the accounting information to be submitted to the Commission for the purpose of the clearance of the accounts of the EAGF and EAFRD as well as for monitoring and forecasting purposes

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1290/2005 of 21 June 2005 on the financing of the common agricultural policy (¹), and in particular Article 42 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Article 8(1) of Commission Regulation (EC) No 885/2006 of 21 June 2006 laying down detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EC) No 1290/2005 as regards the accreditation of paying agencies and other bodies and the clearance of the accounts of the EAGF and of the EAFRD (²) provides that the form and content of the accounting information referred to in Article 7(1)(c) of that Regulation and the way it is to be forwarded to the Commission are to be established.
- (2) The form and content of the accounting information to be submitted to the Commission for the purpose of the clearance of the accounts of the European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF) and of the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) as well as for monitoring and forecasting purposes are presently laid down in Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 909/2011 (³).
- (3) The Annexes to Implementing Regulation (EU) No 909/2011 cannot be used for their intended purposes

in the financial year 2013. Implementing Regulation (EU) No 909/2011 should therefore be repealed and replaced by a new regulation setting out the form and content of the accounting information for that financial year.

(4) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Agricultural Funds Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The form and content of the accounting information referred to in Article 7(1)(c) of Regulation (EC) No 885/2006 and the way it is to be forwarded to the Commission shall be as set out in Annexes I (X Table), II (Technical specifications for the transfer of computer files to the EAGF and EAFRD), III (Aide-mémoire) and IV (Structure of EAFRD budget codes [F109]) to this Regulation.

Article 2

Implementing Regulation (EU) No 909/2011 is repealed with effect from 16 October 2012.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the seventh day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union.

It shall apply from 16 October 2012.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

establishing the standard import values for determining the entry price of certain fruit and vegetables

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 of 22 October 2007 establishing a common organisation of agricultural markets and on specific provisions for certain agricultural products (Single CMO Regulation) (¹),

Having regard to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 543/2011 of 7 June 2011 laying down detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 in respect of the fruit and vegetables and processed fruit and vegetables sectors (²), and in particular Article 136(1) thereof,

Whereas:

 Implementing Regulation (EU) No 543/2011 lays down, pursuant to the outcome of the Uruguay Round multilateral trade negotiations, the criteria whereby the Commission fixes the standard values for imports from third countries, in respect of the products and periods stipulated in Annex XVI, Part A thereto.

(2) The standard import value is calculated each working day, in accordance with Article 136(1) of Implementing Regulation (EU) No 543/2011, taking into account variable daily data. Therefore this Regulation should enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The standard import values referred to in Article 136 of Implementing Regulation (EU) No 543/2011 are fixed in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

DECISION OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE MEMBER STATES

THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 19 thereof,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Articles 254 and 255 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Pursuant to Articles 5 and 7 of the Protocol on the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Union and following the resignation of Mr Enzo MOAVERO MILANESI, a judge should be appointed to the General Court for the remainder of Mr Enzo MOAVERO MILANESI's term of office, which runs until 31 August 2013.
- (2) Mr Guido BERARDIS has been proposed for the vacant post.
- (3) The panel set up by Article 255 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union has given an opinion

on Mr Guido BERARDIS's suitability to perform the duties of a judge of the General Court,

HAVE ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Mr Guido BERARDIS is hereby appointed to the General Court as a judge for the period from 7 September 2012 to 31 August 2013.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union.
