of 24 February 2022

appointing the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work

(2022/C 92/01)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to the Council Decision of 22 July 2003 setting up an Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Having regard to the list of candidates submitted to the Council by the Governments of the Member States,

Whereas:

- (1) By means of its Decision of 12 March 2019 ⁽²⁾, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work for the period from 1 March 2019 until 28 February 2022.
- (2) The members and alternate members remain in office until they are replaced or their terms of office are renewed.
- (3) Members and alternate members of the Committee should be appointed for a period of three years,

The following information is brought to the attention of the persons and entities designated in the Annex I to Council Decision 2012/642/CFSP ⁽¹⁾, as amended by Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/307 ⁽²⁾, and in Annex I to Council Regulation (EC) No 765/2006 ⁽³⁾, as implemented by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/300 ⁽⁴⁾, concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Belarus.

The Council of the European Union, after having reviewed the list of persons and entities designated in the above-mentioned Annexes, has determined that the restrictive measures provided for in Decision 2012/642/CFSP and Regulation (EC) No 765/2006 should continue to apply to those persons and entities. The grounds for designations of those persons and entities appear in the relevant entries in those Annexes.

The attention of the persons and entities concerned is drawn to the possibility of making an application to the competent authorities of the relevant Member State(s) as indicated in the websites in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 765/2006, in order to obtain an authorisation to use frozen funds for basic needs or specific payments (cf. Article 3 of the Regulation).
