

## COMMISSION DECISION

of 14 February 1973

discontinuing the twenty-second partial invitation to tender for white sugar issued under  
Regulation (EEC) No 1897/72

(73/39/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the Euro-  
pean Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 1009/67/  
EEC <sup>(1)</sup> of 18 December 1967 on the common orga-  
nization of the market in sugar, as last amended by  
Regulation (EEC) No 174/73 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular  
Article 17 (4) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1897/72  
<sup>(3)</sup> of 1 September 1972 on a standing invitation  
to tender to determine the export refund for white  
sugar as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No  
2847/72 <sup>(4)</sup>, requires Member States to issue partial  
invitations to tender for the export of white sugar;

Whereas, pursuant to Article 4 (3) of Council Regu-  
lation (EEC) No 766/68 <sup>(5)</sup> of 18 June 1968 laying down  
general rules for granting export refunds on sugar,  
as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 433/72 <sup>(6)</sup>,  
the maximum amount of the refund is fixed for  
partial invitations to tender within three working  
days following the expiry of the time limit for the  
submission of tenders; whereas, when the maximum  
amount of the refund is being calculated, account  
must be taken of the supply situation and prices  
within the Community, prices and potential outlets  
on the world market and costs incurred in exporting  
sugar; whereas, however, pursuant to Article 6 (1) of  
Commission Regulation (EEC) No 394/70 <sup>(7)</sup> of

2 March 1970 on detailed rules for granting export  
refunds on sugar, a decision may be taken to dis-  
continue the tender;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision  
are in accordance with the Opinion of the Manage-  
ment Committee for Sugar;

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The twenty-second partial invitation to tender issued  
under Regulation (EEC) No 1897/72, the time limit  
for the submission of tenders in response to which  
expired on 14 February 1973, is hereby discontinued.

*Article 2*

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
