

COMMISSION DECISION

of 30 July 1979

fixing, pursuant to the invitation to tender opened by Regulation (EEC) No 1420/79, the maximum amounts for the costs of delivery of skimmed-milk powder as food aid

(79/723/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

The maximum amounts to be set for the purposes of awarding a contract pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 1420/79 shall be fixed as follows (in ECU):

Whereas, pursuant to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1420/79 of 6 July 1979 on the delivery of various consignments of skimmed-milk powder as food aid⁽³⁾, the intervention agencies of the Member States have invited tenders for the costs of delivery as food aid of 21 832 tonnes of skimmed-milk powder for certain third countries and beneficiary organizations;

Whereas, in pursuance of Article 14 (2) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 303/77 of 14 February 1977 laying down general rules for the supply of skimmed-milk powder and butteroil as food aid⁽⁴⁾, the tender introduced for Lot H may be a part-quantity of 500 tonnes or a multiple of 500 tonnes of the whole of the lot concerned;

Whereas, Article 16 of the aforementioned Regulation lays down that, on the basis of tenders received, a maximum amount shall be fixed for each lot put up for tender or it shall be decided not to proceed with the tender;

Whereas, on the basis of the tenders received, the maximum amounts should be those specified below;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,
