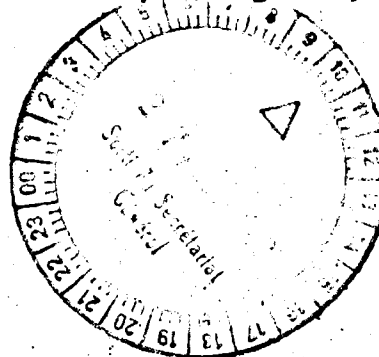

Proposed amendment to TAC and quotas for 1982 contained in document COM (82) 340 final of 18 June 1982 amended by documents COM (82) 340 final 2 of 8 July 1982 and COM (82) 539 final of 29.07.1982

During its meeting of July 1982, ACFM recommended to forbid temporary fishing for capelin in ICES-areas XIV and V in order to allow the rebuilding of the spawning stock to a level necessary to ensure the re-opening of the capelin fishery at a later date.

This recommendation has been included in the conclusions of trilateral consultations between the Community, Norway and Iceland which were held in mid-July concerning the management of this stock.

Taking into account the commitments already undertaken pursuant to the above-mentioned recommendation, the Community cannot forbid third countries fishermen to fish for capelin.

It is therefore necessary to amend annexes I and II to document COM (82) 340 final of 18.06.1982, concerning the TAC and the part of the TAC available for the Community, as indicated hereafter.
