TEXT PROPOSED  
BY THE COMMISSIONAMENDMENTS  
BY PARLIAMENT

*The members of the committee shall establish close cooperation to ensure inter alia that:*

- *the conditions required for unproblematic cross-border membership are met;*
- *distortions of competition are avoided;*
- *national social and labour law provisions are duly observed when institutions are managing a scheme on a cross-border basis;*
- *basic principles are agreed upon for the processing of complaints.*

*The committee shall be the body in which the authorities, at regular intervals, inform one another of relevant social and labour law provisions and changes thereto.*

*Detailed provisions shall be laid down in a protocol adopted by the Member States not later than 31 December 2002.*

Amendment 106

Article 20, paragraph 7c (new)

*7c. Cross-border activities as provided for in this Article shall not be allowed where statutory provisions or collective bargaining provisions exist requiring undertakings to be members of specific institutions for retirement provision.*

**European Parliament legislative resolution on the proposal for a European Parliament and Council directive on the activities of institutions for occupational retirement provision (COM(2000) 507 — C5-0596/2000 — 2000/0260(COD))**

(Codecision procedure: first reading)

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2000) 507) <sup>(1)</sup>,
- having regard to Articles 251(2), 47(2), 55 and 95 of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C5-0596/2000),
- having regard to Rule 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs and the opinions of the Committee on Employment and Social Affairs and the Committee on Women's Rights and Equal Opportunities (A5-0220/2001),

1. Approves the Commission proposal as amended;
2. Asks to be consulted again should the Commission intend to amend the proposal substantially or replace it with another text;
3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
