**TEXTS ADOPTED****P5\_TA(2004)0310****Common rules for carriage of goods by road \*\*\*I****European Parliament legislative resolution on the proposal for a European Parliament and Council directive on the establishment of common rules for certain types of carriage of goods by road (codified version) (COM(2004) 47 – C5-0055/2004 – 2004/0017(COD))**

(Codecision procedure)

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Commission proposal to the European Parliament and the Council (COM(2004) 47) <sup>(1)</sup>,
  - having regard to Articles 251(2) and 71(1) of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Commission submitted its proposal to Parliament (C5-0055/2004),
  - having regard to Rules 67, 89 and 158(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the report of the Committee on Legal Affairs and the Internal Market (A5-0250/2004),
1. Approves the Commission proposal;
  2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it intends to amend its proposal substantially or replace it with another text;
  3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
