Call for proposals for placement of specific training in advanced research within the aeronautics area of the programme Industrial and Materials Technologies (1992-1994)

(93/C 36/10)

In pursuance of the Council Decision (1) authorizing a programme of research and technological development in the field of Industrial and Materials Technologies, the Commission of the European Communities invites proposals for placement of trainees in advanced aeronautical research.

The objectives of the action:

- to provide aeronautics employers with qualified scientists and researchers with experience of working in multinational collaborative projects;
- to widen involvement in Community aeronautics research projects by giving Small and Medium Enterprises (SME's) and companies in countries not having large aeronautical industries additional opportunities to work with the major aeronautical industries and research organizations;

 to contribute to the process of dissemination of knowledge gained from the implementation of EC aeronautical research projects.

The available places and work topics for this specific training are located within the cooperative aeronautical research projects which have been selected for implementation in Area 3 Aeronautics of the programme Industrial and Materials Technologies.

Trainees must be in employment at the time of proposal and continue in that employment during the period of training. The trainee's employer will remain responsible for the trainee's salary cost during the training period. Travel and subsistence costs will be borne by the European Community. Assistance is provided to a sending organization which is an SME.

The duration of training placement will normally be about 18 months (with a minimum of 6 months and a maximum of 24 months). The training location must be in a country different from that of the trainee's normal employment.
