3. a) Exhaustive description of the area(s) covered by the call for expressions of interest: The organization and carrying out of a series of training sessions for officials and other agents of the Commission of the European Union.

This training, which will be in French, English and German, is aimed at a multilingual population with very diverse tasks and responsibilities and not necessarily having specific knowledge of economics.

The course programme will be subdivided into 2 independent but complementary modules:

- 1 module of (3 to) 5 days handling economic, monetary and financial political themes.
