COMMISSION DECISION

of 11 September 1980

to take no action on the tenders submitted by 11 September 1980 in response to the invitation to tender for the export of rye issued in Regulation (EEC) No 2225/80

(80/928/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1870/80 (2),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2746/75 of 29 October 1975 laying down general rules for granting export refunds on cereals and criteria for fixing the amount of such refunds (3), and in particular Article 5 thereof,

Whereas an invitation to tender for the export refund on rye was issued under Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2225/80 (4);

Whereas Article 5 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 279/75 of 4 February 1975 (5), as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2944/78 (6), allows the Commission to decide, in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 26 of Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 and on the basis of the tenders submitted, to make no award:

Whereas on the basis of the criteria laid down in Articles 2 and 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 2746/75 a maximum refund should not be fixed;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

No action shall be taken on the tenders submitted by 11 September 1980 in response to the invitation to tender for the export refund on rye issued in Regulation (EEC) No 2225/80.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
