## REGOLAMENT TA' IMPLIMENTAZZJONI TAL-KUMMISSJONI (UE) Nru 865/2013

tad-9 ta' Settembru 2013

li jemenda r-Regolament (KE) Nru 1010/2009 fir-rigward ta' arrangamenti amministrattivi ma' pajjiżi terzi dwar iċ-ċertifikat tal-qbid għall-prodotti tas-sajd tal-baħar

IL-KUMMISSJONI EWROPEA,

Wara li kkunsidrat it-Trattat dwar il-Funzjonament tal-Unjoni Ewropea,

Wara li kkunsidrat ir-Regolament tal-Kunsill (KE) Nru 1005/2008 <sup>(1)</sup> tad-29 ta' Settembru 2008 li jistabbilixxi sistema Komunitarja sabiex tipprevjeni, tiskoraġġixxi u telimina sajd illegali, mhux irrappurtat u mhux irregolat, u b'mod partikolari l-Artikoli 12(4), 14(4), 20(3) u 52 tiegħu,

Billi:

- (1) L-arrangamenti amministrattivi ma' pajjiżi terzi dwar iċ-ċertifikati tal-qbid għall-prodotti tas-sajd huma elenkati fl-Anness IX tar-Regolament (KE) Nru 1010/2009 tat-22 ta' Ottubru 2009 li jstipula regoli dettaljati għall-implimentazzjoni tar-Regolament tal-Kunsill (KE) Nru 1005/2008 <sup>(2)</sup>. Dawn l-arrangamenti jinkludu kampjuni taċ-ċertifikati tal-qbid ivalidati mill-awtoritajiet kompetenti tal-pajjiżi terzi kkonċernati.
- (2) L-awtoritajiet ta' New Zealand emendaw il-format taċ-ċertifikat tal-kampjun tal-qabdi ta' New Zealand.

- (3) Għaldaqstant, jehtieg li l-Anness IX tar-Regolament (KE) Nru 1010/2009 jiġi emendat skont dan.

- (4) Il-miżuri previsti f'dan ir-Regolament huma skont l-opinjoni tal-Kumitat dwar is-Sajd u l-Akkwakultura,
