European Parliament decision on the numerical strength of the interparliamentary delegations, delegations to joint parliamentary committees and delegations to parliamentary cooperation committees

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 188 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to its decision of 10 March 2004 on the number of interparliamentary delegations, delegations to joint parliamentary committees and delegations to parliamentary cooperation committees⁽¹⁾,

1. decides that the numerical strength of the parliamentary delegations shall be as follows:
