Application for annulment of the decision refusing a request for payment of 100 % of the applicant's medical expenses

Operative part of the order

1. Mr Marcuccio's action is dismissed, in part as manifestly inadmissible and in part as manifestly lacking any foundation;
2. Mr Marcuccio is ordered to pay the costs;
3. Mr Marcuccio is ordered to pay the Tribunal the sum of EUR 1 500.

- Annul the decision of the Director of the Directorate General for Personnel and Administration of the Commission of 9 October 2009 (ADMIN.B2/JJ/jm 0(09)) whereby the administration decided it did not need to take action in respect of the applicant's request to the Commission for assistance of 29 January 2009;
- Compensate the applicant for material and non-material damage suffered by reason of the acts of harassment;
- Order the European Commission to pay the costs.
