- Lechner who, referring to a press release outlining the opinion of the Advocate-General of the Court of Justice, according to which the directive concerning the ban on tobacco advertising, which Parliament had adopted by a majority, should be annulled, felt that Parliament would have done well to agree to the request to postpone the vote on the Maaten report (A5-0156/2000 Minutes of that sitting, Item 12), which had been made at the beginning of the vote; he suggested that the Commission withdraw its proposal for a directive;
