Remarks:

- Mr Corbett, rapporteur, pointed out that amendments 1 and 73 were complimentary and should therefore be put to the vote at the same time (the President noted that there was no objection to this);
- Mr Onesta, with the agreement of the rapporteur, moved an oral amendment to Rule 108 which should read: 'At the request of one-tenth of its component Members, Parliament may, on the basis of a report ... (rest unchanged)'. Mr Wuermeling opposed this oral amendment (the President then noted that more than twelve Members opposed the oral amendment which was therefore not taken into consideration under Rule 139(6));
- Mr Dell'Alba asked for an explanation of the expression 'financial market measures' in amendment 172 (the President, having consulted Mr Corbett, rapporteur, suggested, with the latter's agreement that these words be replaced by 'financial services measures', and noted that there were no objections to his suggestion);
- Mr Wuermeling proposed that amendment 144 be considered as having fallen as a result of the adoption of amendment 142. Both the rapporteur and the President agreed with this. As Mr Wuermeling had noted discrepancies between certain language versions of amendments 49, 120, and 174, the rapporteur pointed out that the House should go by the corrected version of the original text, which meant that these three identical amendments could be put to the vote together.
- Mr Corbett, rapporteur, proposed deleting from the second part of amendment 179 the words 'Rule 121 falls', in view of the rejection of the first part of the amendment (the President established that there would be no objection to this).
- Mr Fatuzzo announced that he had decided not to move an oral amendment to amendment 74.
- Mr Wuermeling stressed the need to maintain linguistic consistency between Rules 159 and 160, and the rapporteur endorsed these remarks.
